3- Course General Objectives:

The aim of the course is to learn about the rules related to civil procedures, After getting acquainted with the Civil Procedures Book 1 about the rules related to the formation of the judicial authority in Syria, the rules for state, specific, value and local jurisdiction, how to write and record the lawsuit, the procedures and order of the sessions, and the case's symptoms, now the civil procedures book 2 is identified with what the judgments are meant, how they are classified and the principles Issued, The rules for correcting judgments, their interpretation, and how to deal with anonymous requests are dealt with, and the general provisions in the appeal are recognized, and each method of appeal is dealt with separately, so the method of appeal by appeal, the method of appeal by cassation, and the way of retrial are also studied. The provisions related to the objection of others, and the rules of the litigation lawsuit are explained to the judges and the representatives of the Public Prosecution, and the subject of the power of attorney for the case, presentation and filing is discussed, The rules related to arbitration are also recognized, so the meaning of the terms included in the arbitration law is recognized, and the court competent to provide legal aid in matters of arbitration, and how to inform the parties to arbitration, how to form the arbitration tribunal, how to conclude an arbitration agreement, and how to file an arbitration suit, How to hold sessions, choose arbitration procedures, how to prove before the arbitrators, clarify the data that must be included in the arbitration award, how to issue the judgment, the date of the arbitration, how to solve the problem of correcting the judgment, its interpretation and the omitted requests, and the case for nullity of the arbitration award and how to give it The executive formula.
